SCREENING INSTRUCTIONS – POLICE INFORMATION / POLICE VULNERABLE SECTOR CHECK

The **Police Information Check** will include the following information, as it exists on the date of the search:

- Current C.P.I.C. entries, such as charges and warrants, judicial orders, Peace Bonds, Probation and Prohibition orders when authorized by the contributing police agency,
- Criminal convictions (summary and indictable) from CPIC and/or local databases,
- Findings of Guilt under the Youth Criminal Justice Act within the applicable disclosure period,
- Absolute (within 1 year) and conditional discharges (within 3 years of conviction).

The **Police Vulnerable Sector Check** will include all of the above and the following information, as it exists on the date of the search:

- Charges resulting in “Not Criminally Responsible by Reason of a Mental Disorder” within 5 years of disposition,
- Exceptional charges resulting in a non-conviction that are sexual offences or frauds targeting the vulnerable sector,
- Record Suspended criminal convictions, identified as a result of a Vulnerable Sector Fingerprint Verification search as authorized for release by the Minister of Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness.

The **Police Information Check or Police Vulnerable Sector Check** will not include:

- Alternative Measures (Withdrawn – Diversions)
- Convictions under provincial statutes
- Foreign information
- Prohibition Orders – Non-Criminal (Driving)
- Negative Police Contacts including non-convictions
- Convictions where a Record Suspension has been granted
- Family Court Restraining Orders
- Charges, convictions and/or extrajudicial measures relating to young persons pursuant to the Youth Criminal Justice Act after the applicable disclosure period ends as per Sec.119(2) of the YCJA

PROCEDURE

1. This form must not be altered. Unauthorized altering of the form is not permitted and may result in criminal charges.
2. The applicant **must** produce ONE (1) piece of appropriate identification that confirm their **name, date of birth and address**. Identification presented must include a **photo**. *Health Cards cannot be recorded for identification purposes but if volunteered it may be viewed. No unauthorized use or disclosure of the Health Card is permitted.* The following is a list of items considered acceptable forms of identification.

- Recent Utility Bill verifying a current Woodstock address may be provided
- People under 16 can provide school ID, Library Card or their parent can provide verification

3. Record checks are processed within approximately one (1) week, assuming timely responses from other police services and depending on request volumes.
4. For a Vulnerable Sector Check fingerprints may have to be submitted if a date of birth and gender match with a person who has received a Record Suspension containing specified sexual offences. Volunteers will be required to produce a letter from the agency stating that they require a Vulnerable Sector Check and naming the applicant as a volunteer with their agency.

Personal information is collected on this form pursuant to the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, s.28 (2), s.32 (b) and the Police Services Act, s.41 for the purpose of processing this record check.
